If the credit(s) is issued by a PA college, then the learner must contact that college's registrar to have them apply the credits toward Act 48 using the PERMS system. The learner should let the college or university registrar's office know in advance that they are requesting to have their graduate credits applied toward Act 48; there may be paperwork that has to be completed by the educator.
